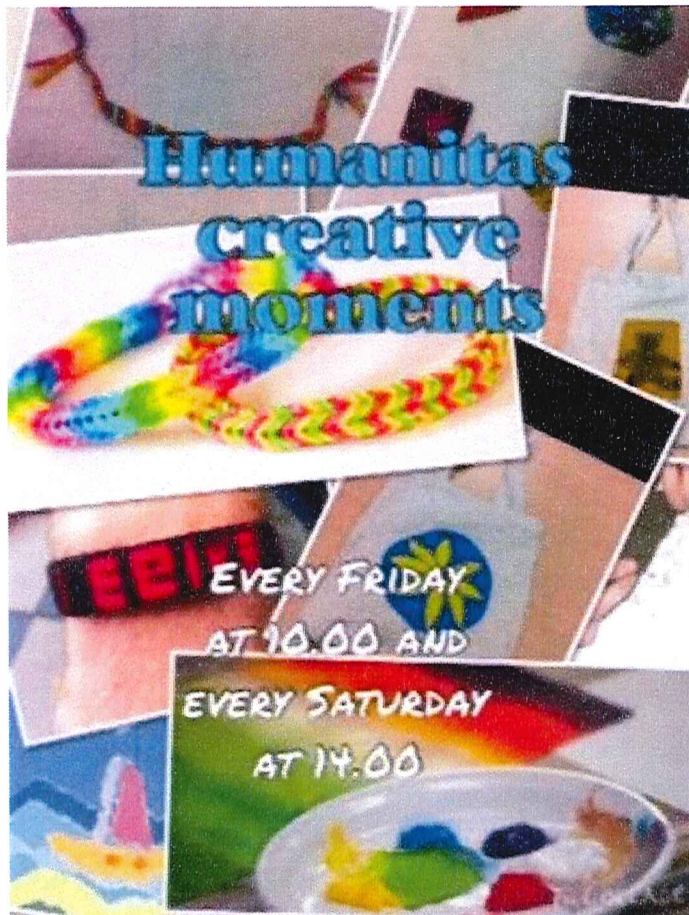


**Humanitas** is an entirely independent non-profit organisation. Its volunteers are ready to serve people who, in a wide variety of situations and circumstances, need a helping hand.

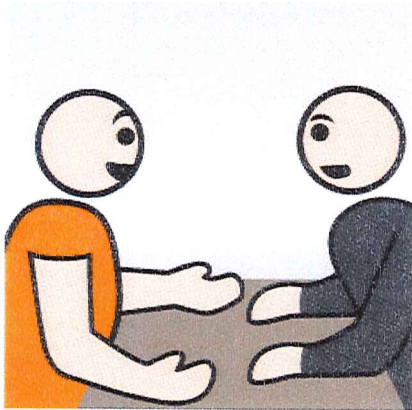
## What can **Humanitas** do for you at Zeist Detention Center?
